Sensory substitution - Wikipedia Sensory substitution is a change of the characteristics of one sensory modality into stimuli of another sensory modality.. A sensory substitution system consists of three parts: a sensor, a coupling system, and a stimulator. The sensor records stimuli and gives them to a coupling system which interprets these signals and transmits them to a stimulator.
